WHAT WE OFFER?

Sasaki offers a unique opportunity for artists who are interested in displaying their work in a non-traditional interactive environment. The exhibition spaces are comprised of both interior and exterior spaces where the artwork takes center stage in the daily lives of our 250+ creative employees, clients, and visitors. Art Exhibitions at Sasaki typically run from 8 to 12 weeks and the work is available for public viewing.

Monday–Friday 8:30 AM–5:30 PM.

The design, printing, and mailing of exhibition announcements is provided to all exhibiting artists along with a public opening reception hosted by Sasaki. Artists are welcome to sell their work. Sasaki does not take commission for any related sales. Individual artists are responsible for all inquiries.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Both established and emerging artists are encouraged to apply, and it is strongly recommended that all applicants visit the space prior to submitting proposals. Special consideration will be made to artists whose work addresses the natural and/or built environment, land use development, landscape, architecture, and/or design.

Application Procedures:

All applicants are required to submit the following in hard-copy or CD-ROM format:

- Artist's Resume including contact information, education, and list of prior exhibitions.
- Artist's Statement
- Images of work, 20 images max (print format or digital format) (jpeg 150 dpi min. on labeled CD-ROM)
